Dinner on Top of the Fall

White Water Rafting on the Jacques Cartier River

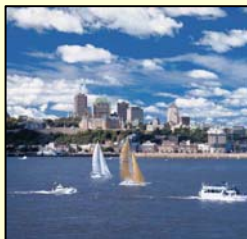

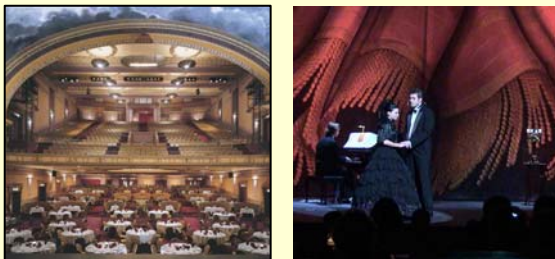
